

Hey what are those yellow buoys on our lake. Well there are 39 hazard buoys on our lake in 15 locations. For those aware of hazards to props or your boat it gives you a signal to stay away. For those that ignore them, the Marina loves the business. The buoys are Transport Canada approved and marked.

We will also respond to cottagers concerned in their area that you deem hazardous to boaters that currently do not have a hazard buoy.



The red and green navigation lights on motor boats. Port is the left-hand side of a vessel, facing forward. Starboard is the right-hand side, We place 21 navigation red and green buoys in 5 locations throughout the busy channels of Catchacoma Lake and Catchacoma Narrows.

Going upstream green is on the left and downstream it is on the right. We try to ensure the buoys are maintained in the correct locations throughout the boating season but we can't guarantee that buoys that have been deployed haven't moved and unmarked locations of the lake can be safely navigated. The primary responsibility for safe boating is with the operator of the vessel. CCA, its directors and volunteers take no responsibility for injury to boaters or damage to boats as a result of contact with navigational hazards.

Does this look familiar? Well boating season has arrived and we want to reminder you that...



Penalties for not having life-jackets for all those on board a boat start at \$200 for one person and go up by \$100 for each missing life-jacket.

Stand-up **Paddleboards** are deemed as navigation —leaving the shoreline

Option 1: WEAR a lifejacket with a whistle Option 2: CARRY a lifejacket on board with whistle and a buoyant heaving line

Option 3: Not complying to option 1 or 2 then fines can apply for non-compliance. Range \$200 – \$500

- If out on the lake after sunset or early sun rise a water proof flashlight is mandatory for paddle boats and canoes
- Observer required towing a skier even on a sea-doo. We suggest you review safety rules for sea-doo at https://www.sea-doo.ca/owners/safety/safety-tips.html

NOTICE TO BOATERS:

§You are responsible for your own wake while touring into bays. Check your wake. Water levels are high this summer meaning that shoreline erosion for boat wakes is a serious problem. Least wake produces boat going dead slow or fast. Half speed causes most damage.

In the summer of 2018, CCA arranged for a Trent University team to undertake water chemistry testing in Catchacoma. The location of the testing was in an area with over 30 metres of water depth in the North

central area of the lake. They collected water samples from the surface waters as well as samples near the lake bottom. In addition they recorded the profile of dissolved oxygen and water temperature from the surface to the bottom.

The results confirmed that our water chemistry and oxygen profile are within the normal range for healthy lakes

In 2019 CCA has arranged for Trent to collect a new set of samples. The real value of this program will come when we have multiple years of data and can identify any trends that may require investigation
